

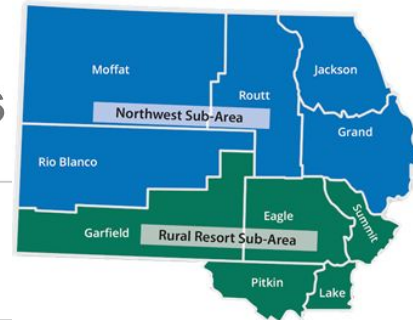
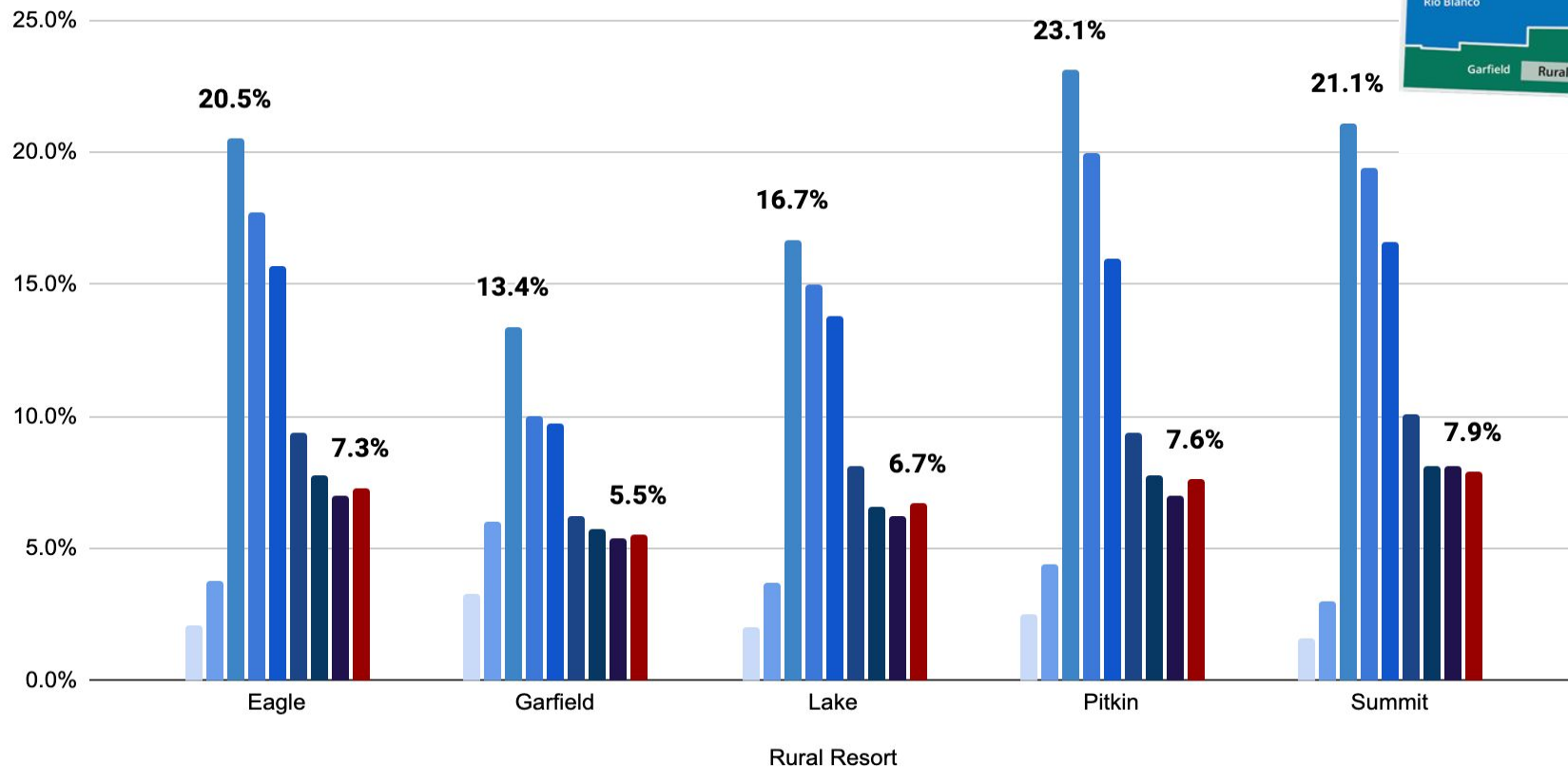

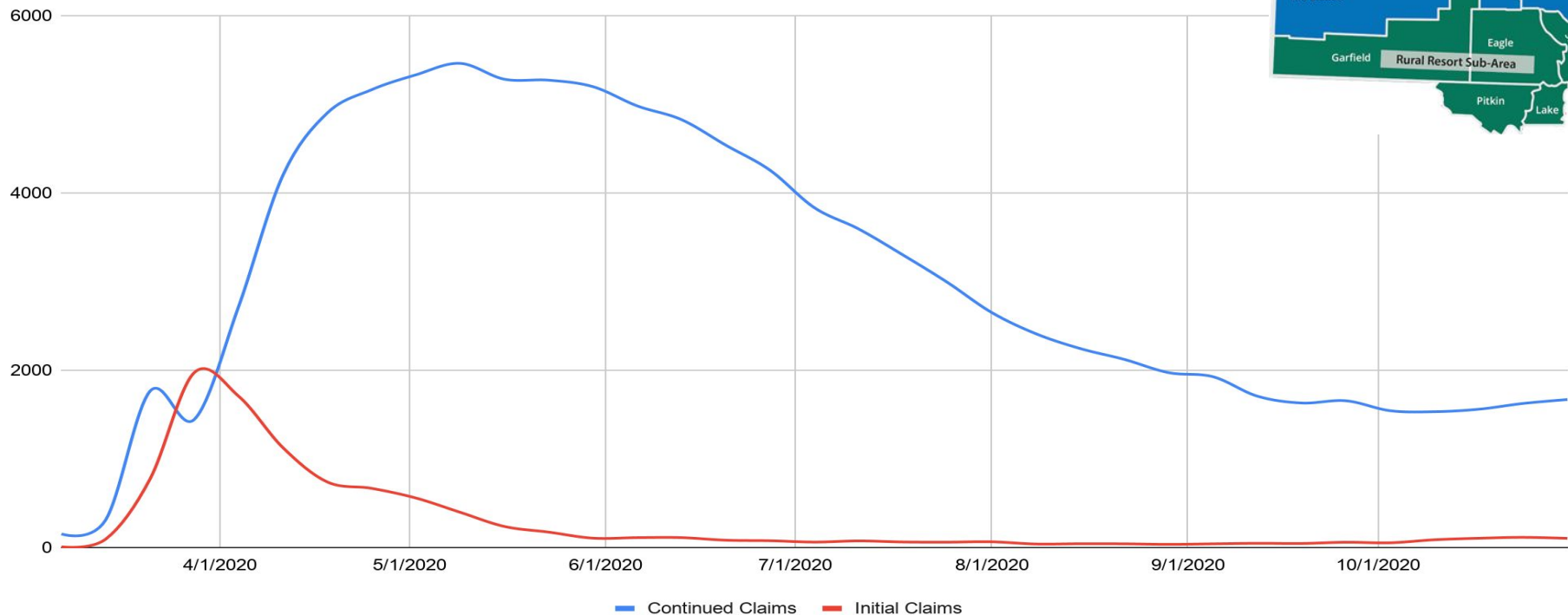
Rural Resort Workforce Area Unemployment Rates

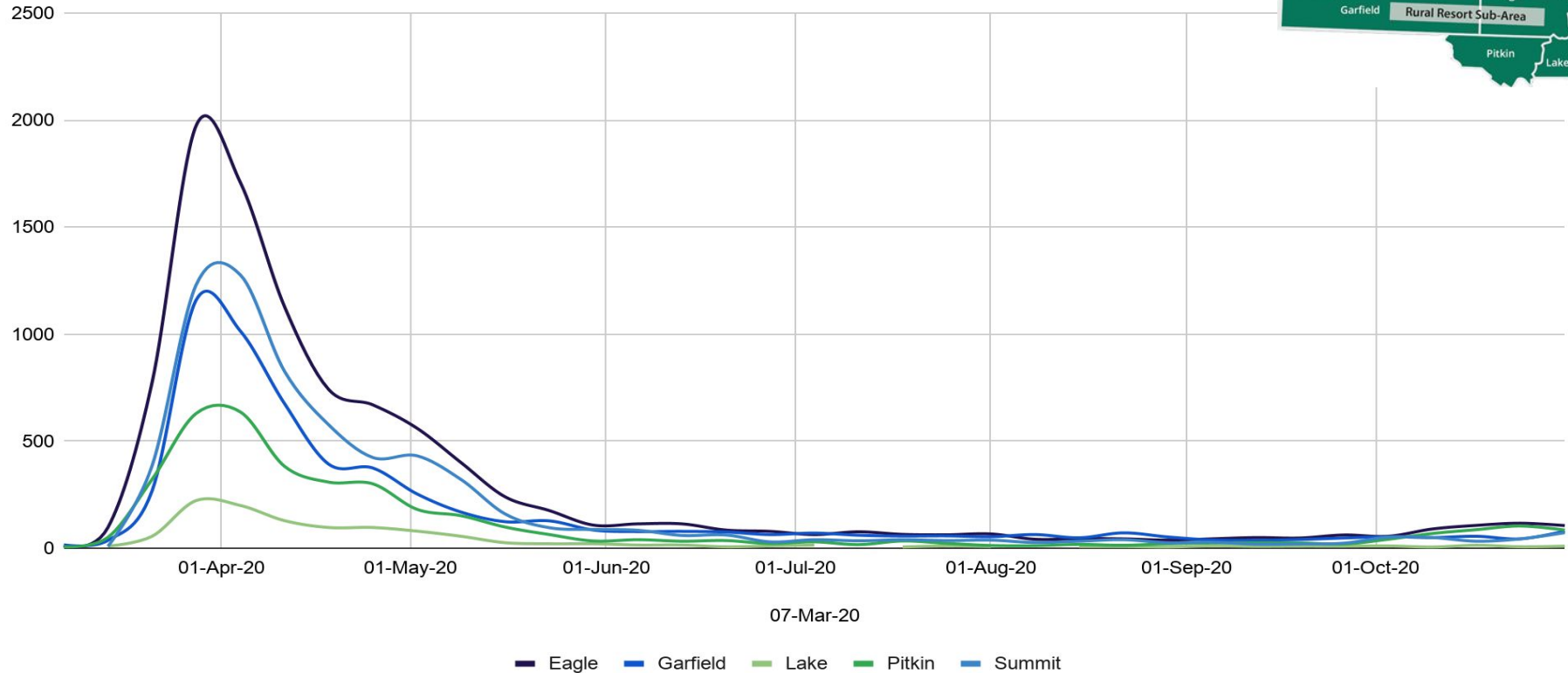

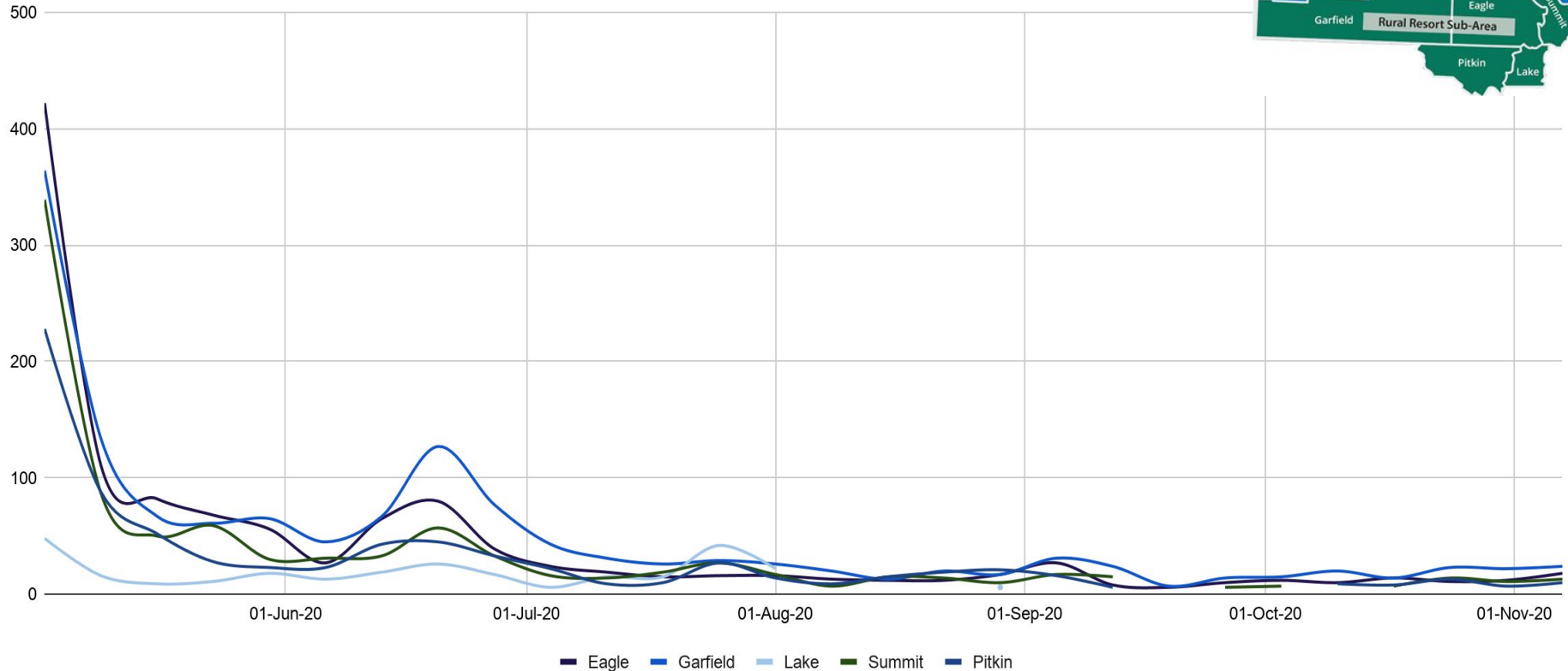

Rural Resort Workforce Area Initial UI Claims



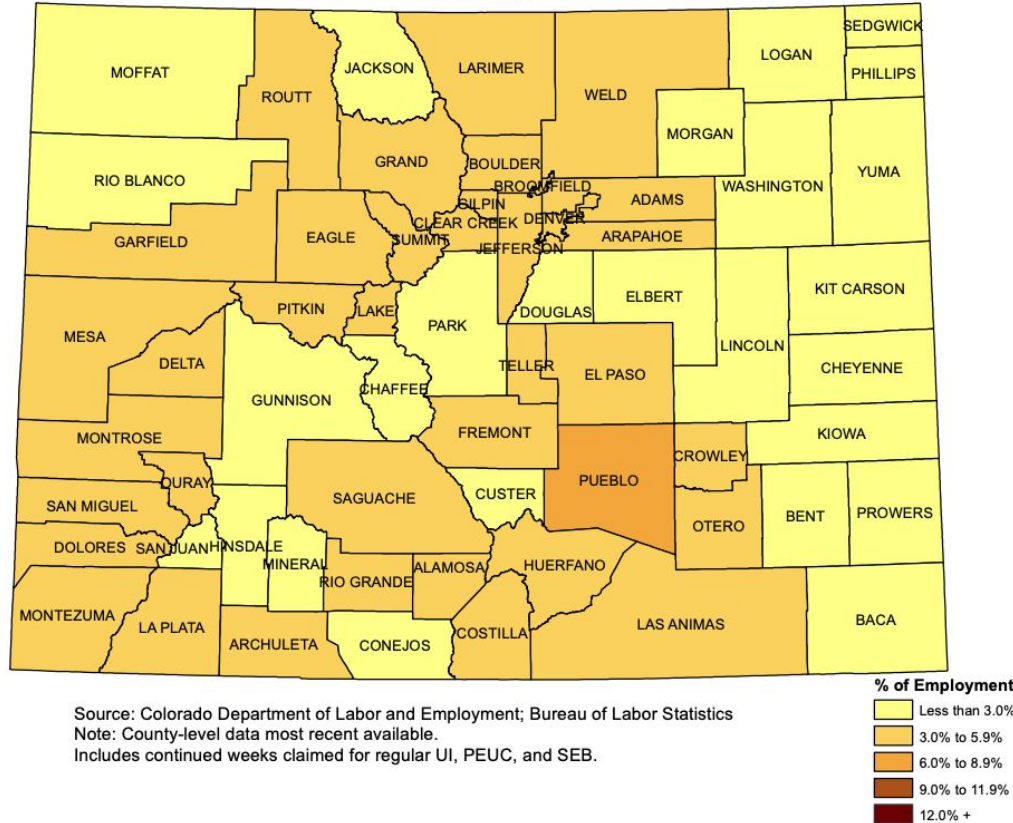

Initial PUA Claims: Rural Resort Sub-Area



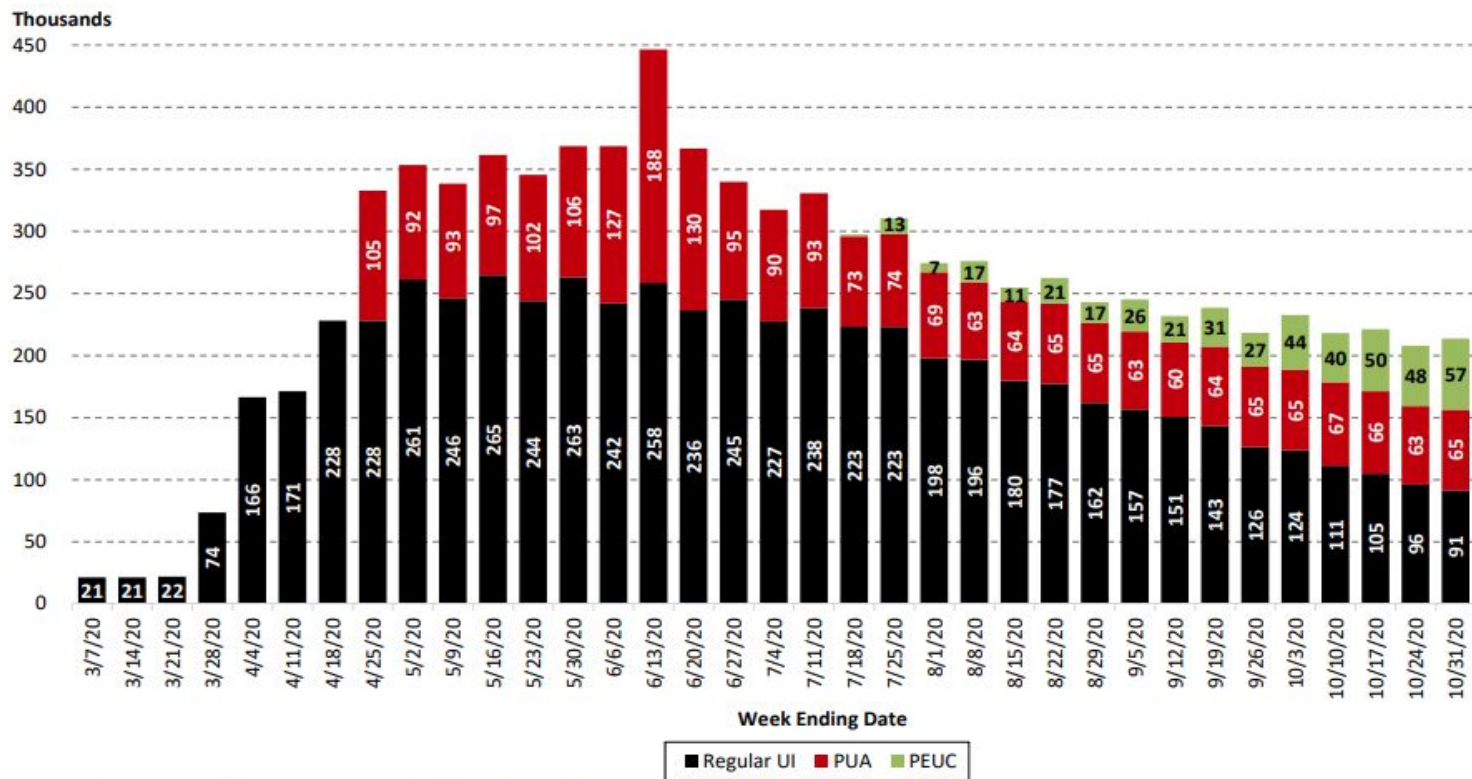

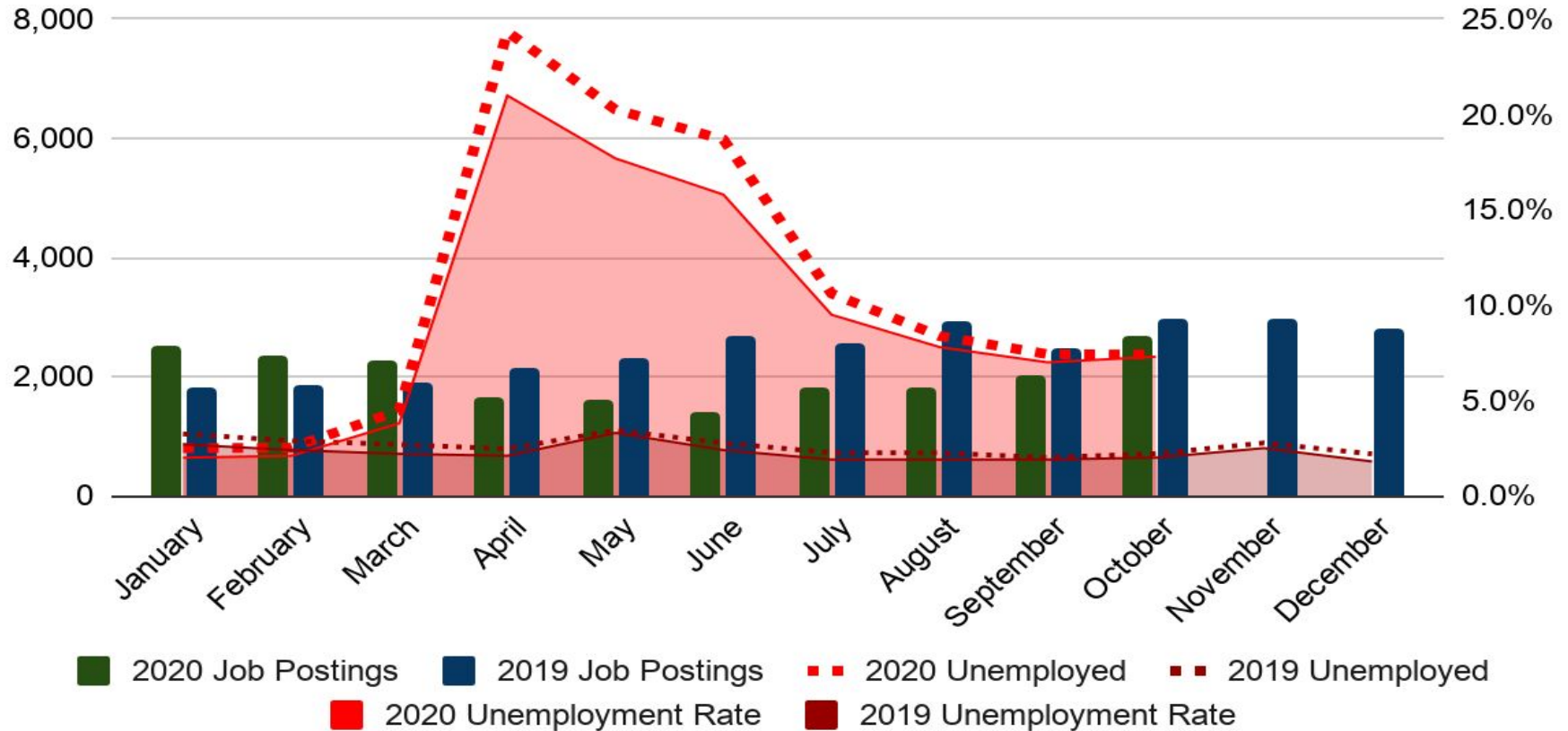
PUA program started in Colorado week ending April 25, 2020. PUA claims totals for week ending 7/18 to 8/22 revised from previously reported.

PEUC program became active in Colorado in early July and extends unemployment benefits by an additional 13 weeks.

***Weekly average of regular UI continued weeks claimed in 2019 was 18,600; during the Great Recession (2009-10) the weekly average was 67,600.

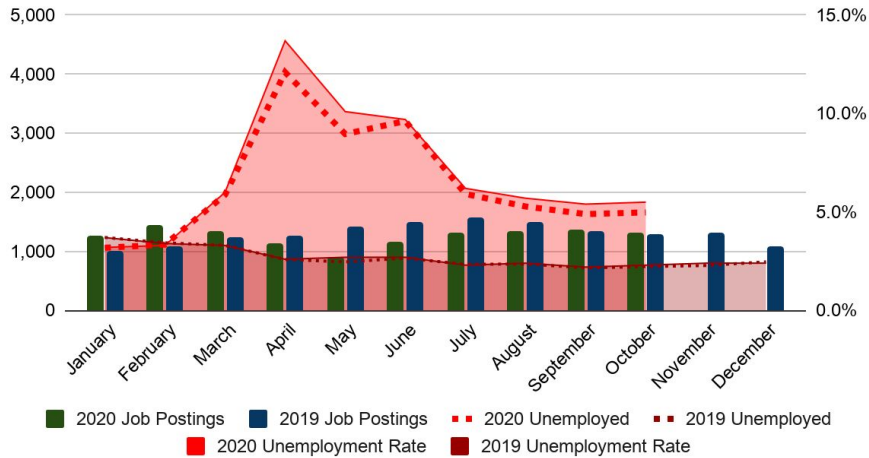
****Weekly average of last federal extension program (Emergency Unemployment Compensation 2008) from 2009-11 was 51,900.

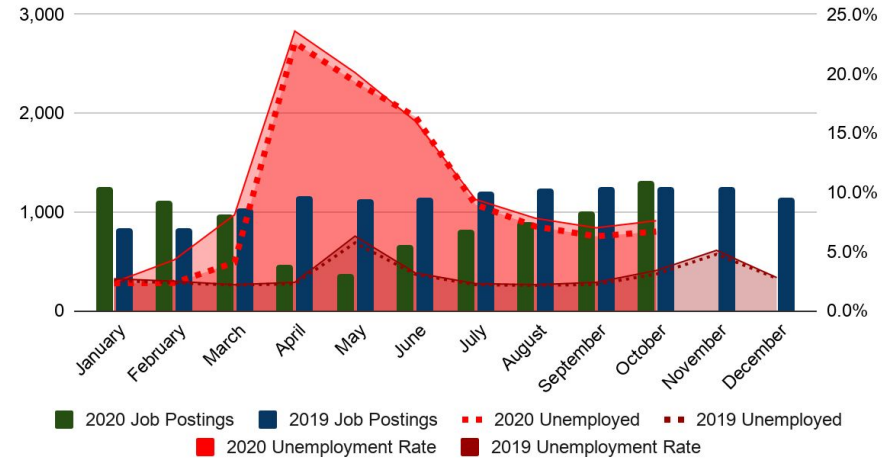

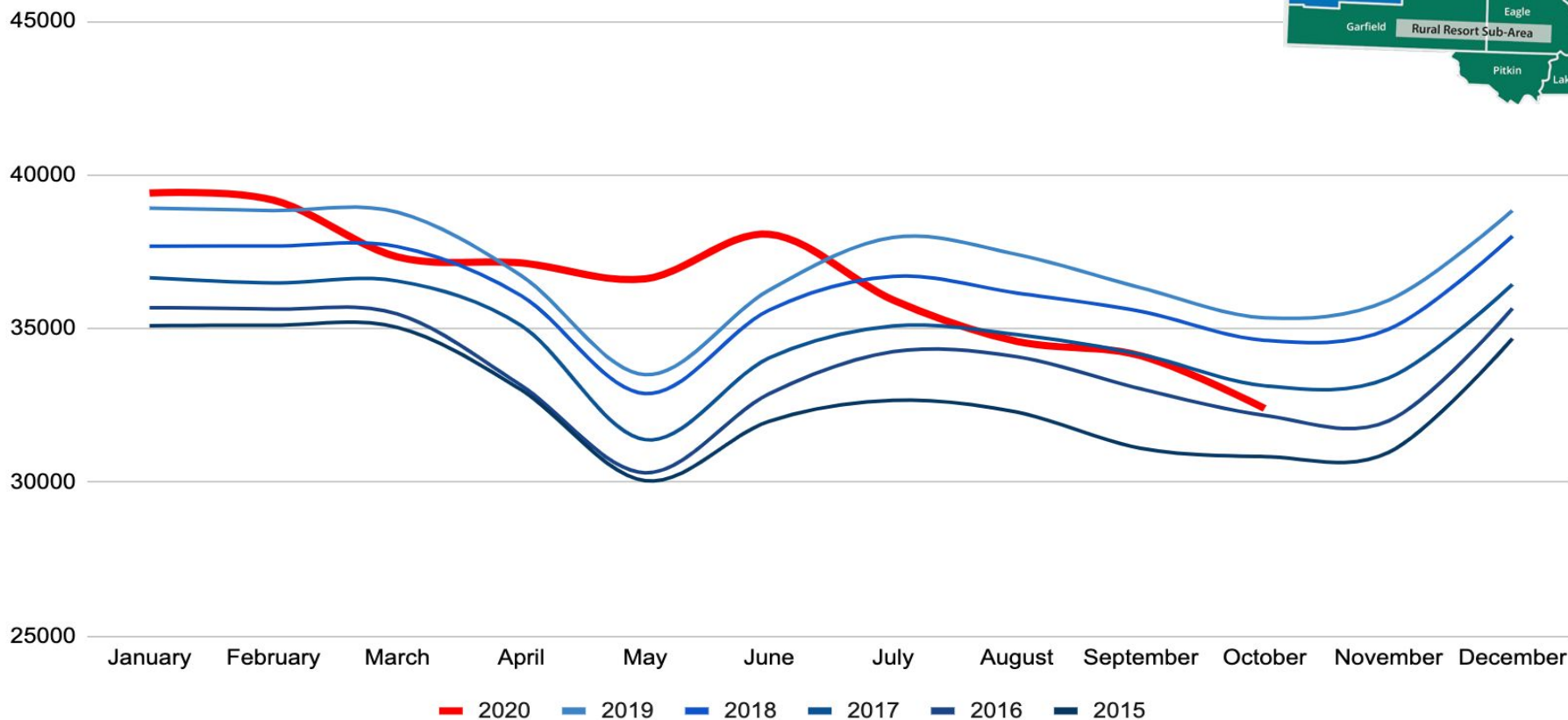


Pitkin County Jobs and Unemployment

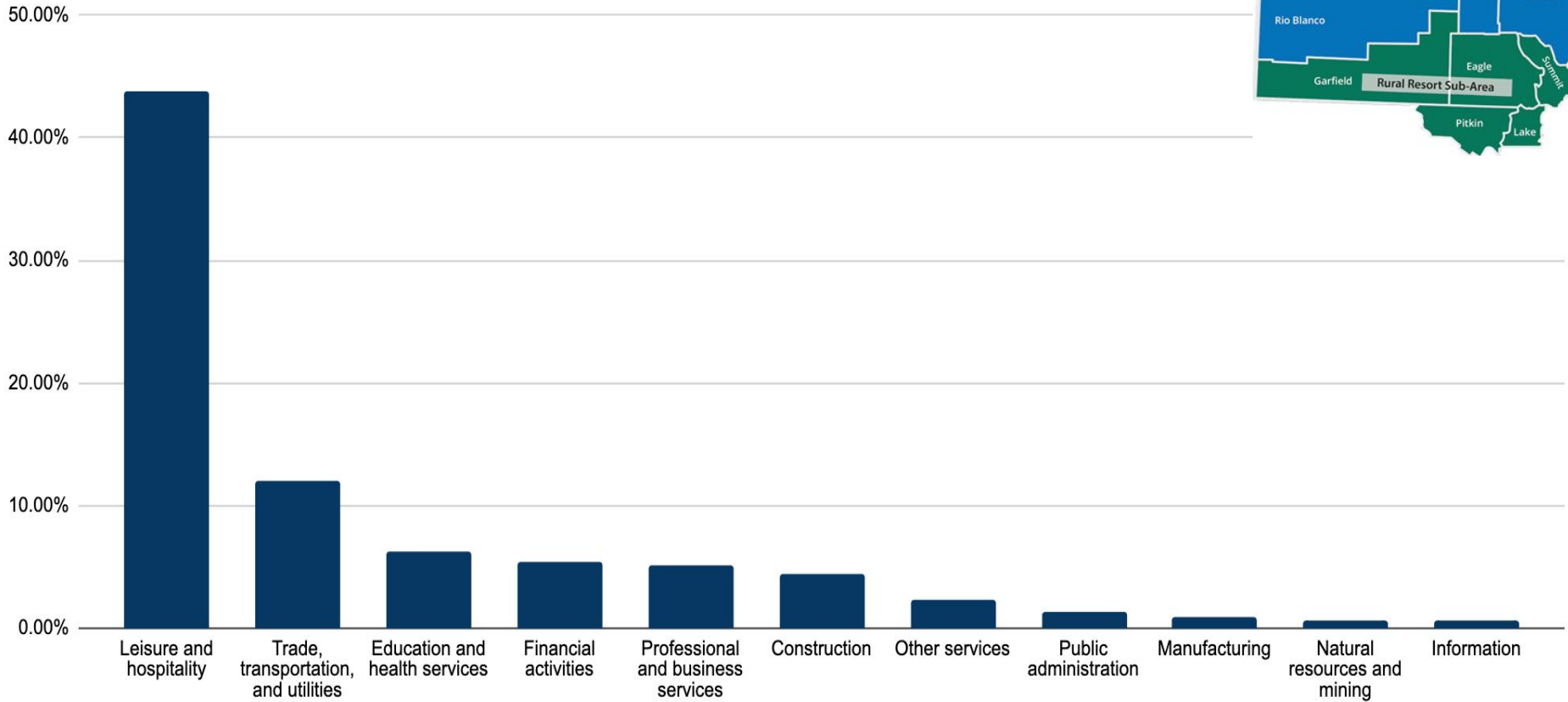

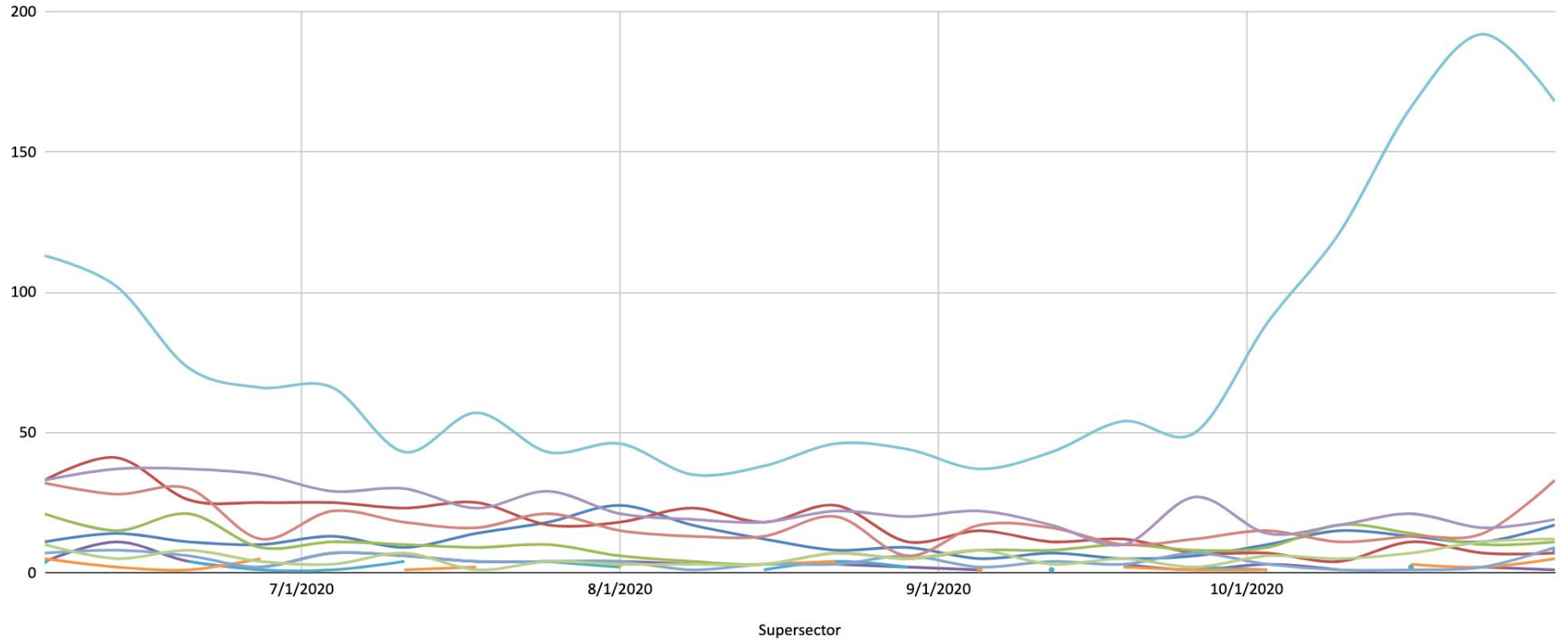
Rural Resort Sub-Area Industry level Initial UI Claims

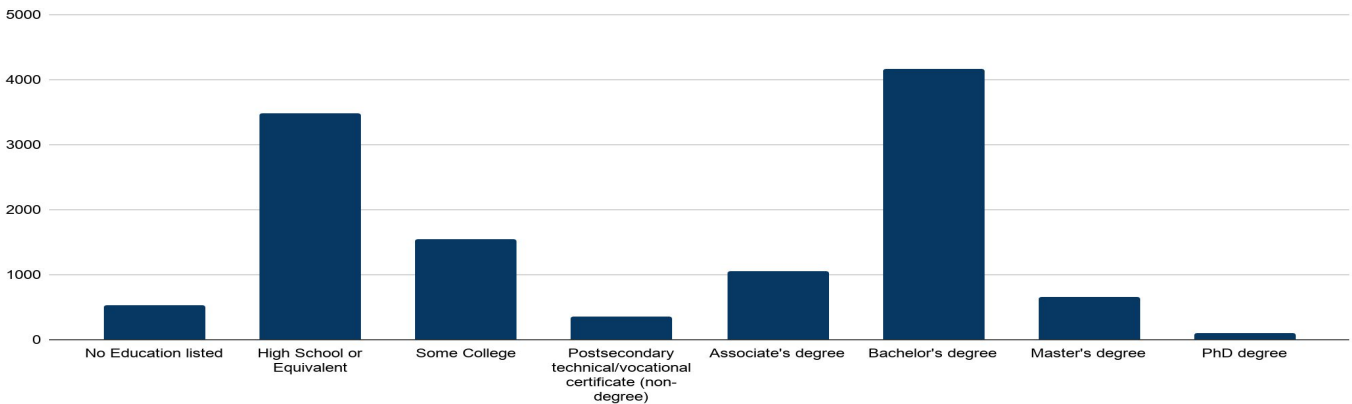

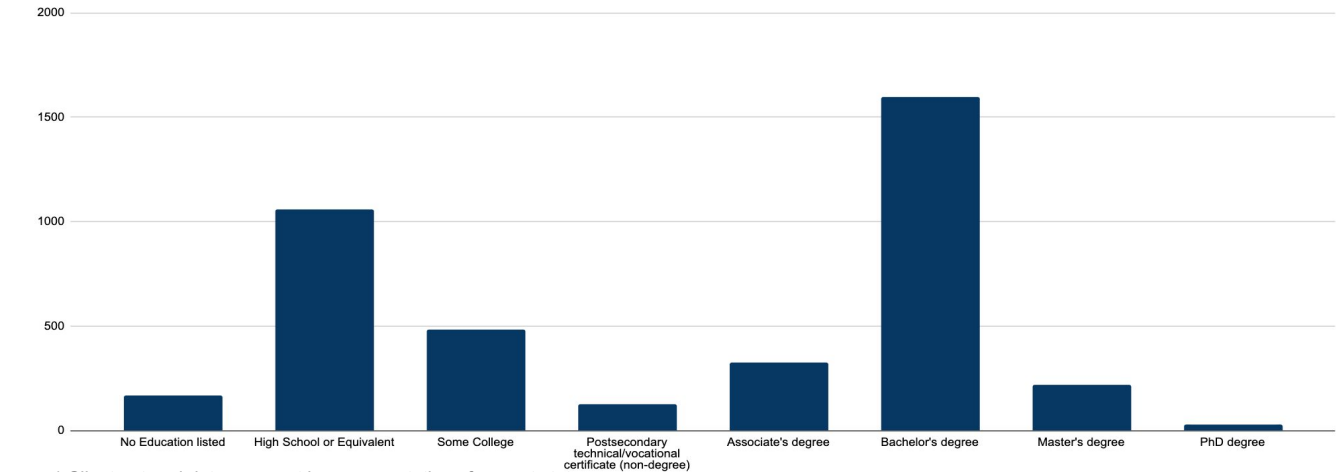

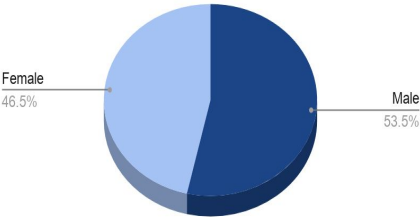
